

INSTALLING SOUNDBAR

Quick Step Guide to Installing the NCE Soundbar

IMPORTANT – Do Not Connect Soundbar to TV when power is active, including plug into the AUX connection of the Soundbar. This may cause distortion and/or damage to the power input and speakers of the Soundbar.



Image 1 - Shows the light on the volume toggle when power is present and the sound is turned up above 0. If not turned up above 0 then no light will appear.



Image 2 - Shows the connection into the rear of the soundbar. Make sure all connections are firm.







Image 3 - Shows the connection from the Soundbar into the TV for sound. The correct lead has two 'silver male' ends.



Image 4 - Shows the power splitter cable. One end into power input on Soundbar, one end into DC power input on TV. Depending on TV model, 12VDC power input on TV could be on the side or the bottom panel.







Image 5 - Shows the power connection with powerpack. Where your normal power input would have been straight into the TV, plug the male end of the powerpack into the female end of the Soundbar splitter.

Once the TV and Soundbar are connected to power and each other, set the volume on the Soundbar Volume button and then control the sound via the TV remote control.

Once the Soundbar is connected to the TV via the earplug jack, it will override all other sound outputs such as TV speaker sound, Bluetooth connection or AV out to another source such as a Audio Head Unit
